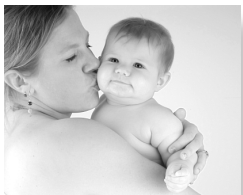

- ❖ Print manipulations~dodging and burning

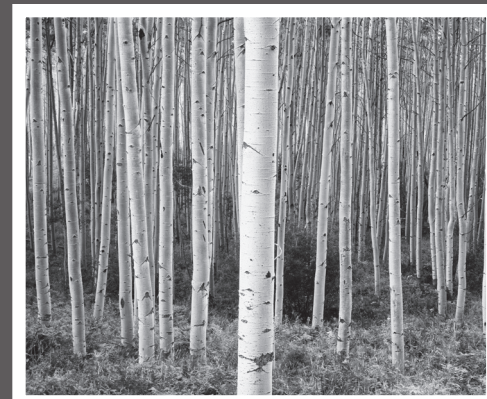
2nd class:
